

San Francisco Sheriff's Office Electronic Monitoring (EM) Program Rules Sentenced Participants

Once you have been enrolled in the EM, you can be taken into custody by the Sheriff to serve the balance of your sentence for any of the following reasons:

- Failure to follow program rules and/or regulations
- Failure to call or come in when instructed to either replace or return a troublesome or problematic equipment
- Any articulable adverse behavior that prevents your successful completion of the program

Program Rules

1.	The participant shall obey all orders given by any sworn employee (Initials)
2.	The participant shall obey all laws (Initials)
3.	The participant shall notify an SFSO sworn employee of any arrest, citation or police contact no later than the
	day after it occurs (Initials)
4.	The participant shall immediately notify an SFSO sworn employee of any change in address or phone
	number (Initials)
5.	The participant shall submit to a search of their person, residence, automobile or property by any peace officer at
	any time (Initials)
6.	The participant must submit to a drug or alcohol test when instructed to do so by sworn SFSO staff
	(Initials)
7.	The participant shall not possess any illegal weapons, drugs or alcohol (Initials)
8.	The participant shall not tamper with, remove or cause the equipment to malfunction. Any of these acts is
	considered as an overt attempt to avoid monitoring or detection. Violation of this rule may result in the
	participant's return to secure custody and filing of additional criminal charges(Initials)
9.	The participant is responsible for all issued equipment.
	a. The participant may be criminally charged with theft for failure to return any issued equipment (Initials)
	b. The participant may be criminally charged with vandalism for damage to any issued equipment(Initials)
10.	All participants must live within 50 miles of the San Francisco Sheriff's Department Community Programs office
	located at 70 Oak Grove Street, San Francisco, CA. Absent permission by SFSD the participant shall not travel
	farther than 50 miles from 70 Oak Grove Street, San Francisco, CA (Initials)
11.	The participant is responsible for keeping the device charged. Failure to do so is a violation the program.
	(Initials)
12.	The participant shall report to the Sheriff's Office located at 70 Oak Grove Street, San Francisco, CA when
	called for device maintenance. Failure to do so is a violation of the program (Initials)



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Home Detention Compliance Considerations

1.	The participant must remain within the interior premises of his / her residence during designated curfew hours.
	The participant is scheduled to be home at least 84 hours per week (Initials)
2.	The participant may engage in only pre-approved activities during non-curfew hours (Initials)
3.	The participant must restrict guests to their residence to no more than three at any one time during curfew hours
	(Initials)
4.	The participant may spend a maximum of 45 hours at a work-site (Initials)
5.	The participant is granted 2.5 hours per week of errand time to attend personal needs such as church services
	or grocery shopping. After one successful month of compliance, the participant will be granted four hours per
	week at a consistent time (to be scheduled before 9pm) (Initials)
6.	Counselling, 12-step meetings and programmatic groups are allowed if they are scheduled and verified. It may
	not exceed eight hours per week (Initials)
7.	The participant must attend any interview as directed by SFSO employees (Initials)
8.	Deviation from the schedule must be requested seven days in advance. This includes court appointments and
	medical appointments (Initials)
9.	Any approved days spent out of zone will not be counted towards the completion of a participant's sentence.
	(Initials)
10.	Three issues of minor non-compliance will result in either a hearing or an automatic warrant. A hearing will be
	conducted before an SFSO supervisor to consider sanctions or termination of participation and placement in jail
	for the remainder of the sentence. One incident of major non-compliance may result in either a hearing or an
	automatic warrant and may result in an additional charge of 4532 P.C. (Escape) (Initials)
